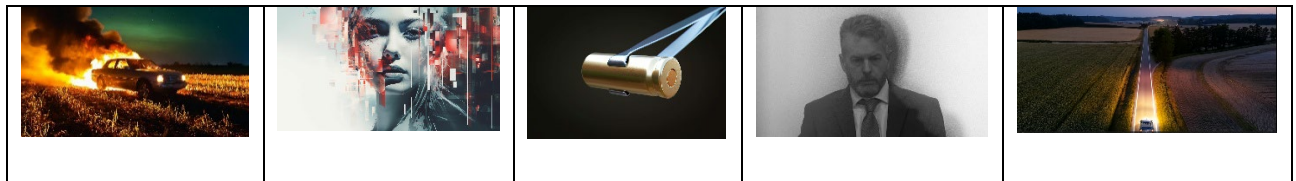
Logline:

A five-episode audio and video podcast series re-examining the arrest and conviction of regional airline pilot Christian “Kit” Martin, uncovering inconsistencies and overlooked clues in a case that drew national attention.

Series Synopsis:

Framed traces the case from November 19, 2015 — the day the murders of three people were discovered — through the complex investigation, shifting theories, and high-profile arrest and trial that followed. Drawing on court records, courtroom video, interviews, and previously overlooked details, the series examines the evidence presented against Christian “Kit” Martin and the alternative explanations that were never fully explored. Across five episodes, *Framed* raises critical questions about the investigation, the prosecution’s narrative, and the broader implications of a case that continues to divide observers. The result is a measured, in-depth re-examination of a conviction that still leaves many unanswered questions.

Episodes



Episode 1 – The Crime, The Evidence, and The Arrest

This episode lays out the basic facts of the triple homicide: who was killed, where, when, and under what circumstances. It details how key pieces of evidence were discovered not by investigators but by family members and concludes with the headline-making arrest of Christian “Kit” Martin at the Louisville International Airport.

Episode 2 – Motive, Means, and Opportunity

Episode two provides background on both the victims and the suspect before examining the prosecution’s theories of motive, means, and opportunity. The episode contrasts these claims with the potential motive and means of an alternative suspect — Martin’s ex-wife.

Episode 3 – Re-examining the Evidence

How strong was the evidence against Kit? This episode highlights the central problems with the case's physical evidence, which consisted primarily of a dog tag, a shell casing, and a .22-caliber bullet.

Episode 4 – Deception

If ever there were a case that demonstrated the value of cameras in the courtroom, this is it. Episode four explores the lengths to which the prosecution went in pursuit of a conviction, revealing troubling inconsistencies and courtroom hijinks seen clearly by Court TV viewers but missed by the jury.

Episode 5 – Nothing but the Truth

The final episode begins by addressing a post-trial claim made by lead detective Scott Smith, who alleged he discovered one of the potential murder weapons in a stairwell in Raleigh, North Carolina. After examining that claim, the episode contrasts the prosecution's disjointed account of the crime with an alternative reconstruction based solely on the available evidence.

Emilio Corsetti III is the author of *I Will Ruin You: The Twisted Truth Behind the Kit Martin Murder Trial*. He created this podcast series after seeing other true-crime podcasters cover the case with incomplete information, factual inaccuracies, and unsupported conclusions. As the author of two previous nonfiction narrative books—and the writer who produced the most detailed account of this story—Emilio brings the knowledge, experience, and authority needed to present the case to a new audience with accuracy and depth. In addition to his work as an author and storyteller, Emilio is a retired airline pilot who served as an international captain, a background that led to his initial interest in this story.
